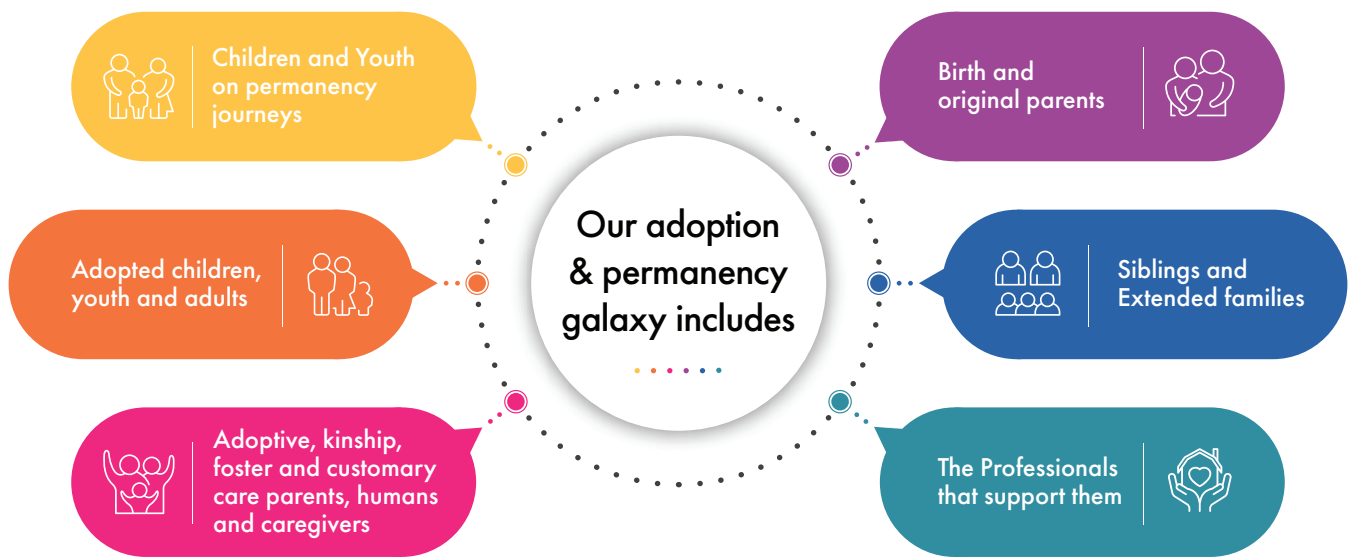


The Adoption Council of Ontario is a charitable organization that educates, supports, connects and advocates for all those touched by adoption and permanency journeys, and the professionals that support them.
